


How to use Zoom Al Companion in the Healthcare and Life Sciences industry








## Meeting Summary

Great for non-clinical meetings with multiple stakeholders (physicians, finance, operations, patient engagement).

- When you use meeting summaries instead of manually taking notes, you save time and everyone can stay engaged in the meeting.
- The meeting host will
   automatically get a summary
   that they can edit and share
   with attendees by email or in
   the dedicated Zoom Team
   Chat channel.



# Smart Recording

Great for board meetings, patient wellness and coaching programs, employee onboarding, and training sessions.

When you save your meeting recordings to the cloud, you can:

- Organize your cloud recordings into smart chapters
- Isolate important highlights
- Identify action items
- Provide the host with data about their presentation performance.



# Meeting Agendas

Great for recurring meetings, such as staff meetings, board meetings, or training sessions.

- Create and share a meeting agenda for your next meeting.
  In the Al Companion side panel or a Zoom Doc, just enter "Create an agenda for my next meeting."
- If it's a recurring meeting, the previous meeting history will be used to create an agenda.





### Zoom Team Chat

Great for non-clinical healthcare teams working in a fast-paced department.

- Zoom Al Companion can compose the first draft of a message, make it longer or shorter, change the tone, and edit it with your own flair before you send it.
- And if you've been busy with patients and you have a lot of new messages, Al Companion can summarize the threads to catch you up quickly.




#### Zoom Phone

Great for healthcare team collaboration, nurse stations, and healthcare professionals who are on the go or in changing environments.

You can use AI Companion to:

- Generate summaries of your phone conversations
- Send you a list of action items from a voicemail
- Summarize your SMS threads





#### Zoom Docs

Great for healthcare team collaboration projects, such as managing patient care plans, project tracking for an upcoming summit, or managing research timelines.

#### You can use Zoom Docs to:

- Take notes, manage projects, and share information with your peers
- Create agendas, project trackers, and summaries of lengthy documentation
- Compose or convert patient care plans into appropriate formats including schedules and outlines
