access than they need**

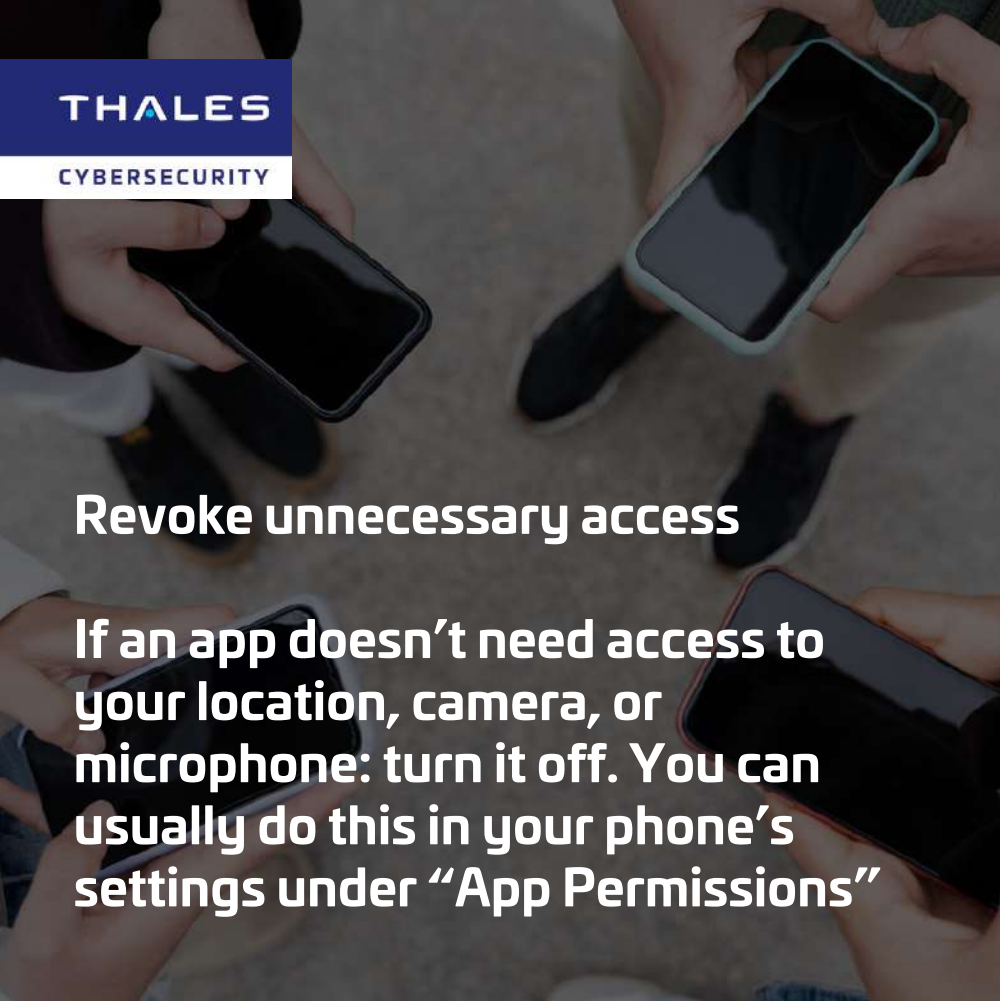

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Audit your phone's app permissions

Tip: Focus on location, camera and microphone

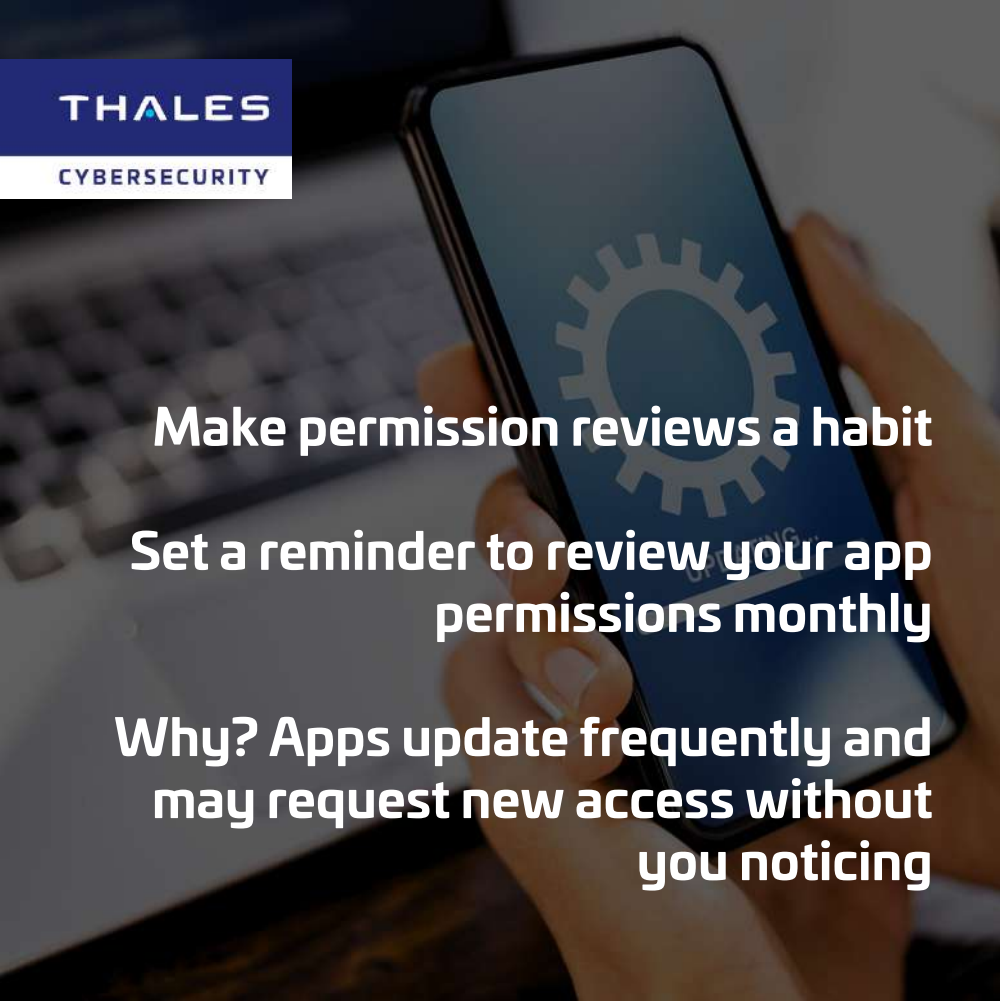

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Revoke unnecessary access

If an app doesn't need access to your location, camera, or microphone: turn it off. You can usually do this in your phone's settings under "App Permissions"

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Make permission reviews a habit

Set a reminder to review your app permissions monthly

Why? Apps update frequently and may request new access without you noticing
