

What is phishing?

Phishing is a cyber attack where attackers **impersonate** legitimate entities to trick you into revealing **sensitive information**, like passwords or credit card numbers.

How to recognize phishing emails

1. Check the sender's email address for **unusual domains**.
2. Beware of **urgent** language.
3. Look for **generic** greetings.
4. Watch for **suspicious links** or attachments.

Steps to take if you receive a phishing email

1. **Do not click** any links or attachments.
2. **Report** the email to your IT department or email provider.
3. **Delete** the email from your inbox.
4. **Monitor** your accounts for suspicious activity.
