What is phishing?

Phishing is a cyber attack where attackers impersonate legitimate entities to trick you into revealing sensitive information, like passwords or credit card numbers.

How to recognize phishing emails

- 1. Check the sender's email address for unusual domains.
- 2. Beware of urgent language.
- 3. Look for generic greetings.
- 4. Watch for suspicious links or attachments.

Steps to take if you receive a phishing email

- 1. Do not click any links or attachments.
- 2. Report the email to your IT department or email provider.
- 3. Delete the email from your inbox.
- 4. Monitor your accounts for suspicious activity.
